### 1. Travel arrangements

- ★ A packet of biscuits (or similar) to share for morning/afternoon teas (MUST NOT CONTAIN NUTS)
- ★ Any medication you require (e.g. puffer etc)
- ★ Appropriate clothes for cold nights & nice days, pyjamas, sneakers for outdoor activities
- ★ Toiletries/towel
- ★ Tea-towel
- ★ Torch
- ★ Bible/paper/pens
- ★ An attitude full of energy and enthusiasm

### 5. What not to bring!

In order to care for the people attending Novo this year, we ask that you do not bring any food items which **CONTAIN NUTS**. Please also respect the rules we have in place regarding the following items. Our duty of care policy for Novo is that if you are found with any of the following, you will be sent home immediately, at the expense of your parents.

- × **Any form of alcohol**
- × **Any form of non-prescribed drugs**
- × **Any form of cigarettes**

Other things we discourage you from bringing:

Electronic equipment, mobile phones, anything of value (jewellery, money, etc.)

There will not be any time on camp to be using phones or devices, and it is expected that any brought to camp are left in dorms, in silent mode. We do not take responsibility for any devices brought to camp.
